## Introduction to Archery Shooting for Women

**June 7<sup>th</sup> 2014**



These are non-competitive clinics designed to introduce women to archery shooting using modern compound bows in a warm, safe, and fun setting without making a costly investment. You will receive one-on-one instruction in the fundamentals and safety procedures needed to enjoy archery shooting in a 3 hour session.

This program addresses the most common question from individuals who have participated in our other events or courses – what can I do next to get better and more confident with a bow? It is also well suited for women who have never handled a modern compound bow and would like to learn.



### Maximum of 12 Participants

#### Program Goals:

- To teach the basics of archery shooting through additional hands-on experience and to identify opportunities for individuals to further participate in those shooting sports to increase their skills and confidence.
- To provide participants who have already purchased a bow or are considering purchasing a bow and have already completed introductory instruction in archery shooting with the additional opportunity to gain experience and learn in a fun, relaxed social environment.

Event will begin at 8:30am with a required range brief / safety instructional session and overview of the rules and procedures of each of the shooting sports beginning presented. Hands-on participation in those shooting sports will follow from 9:00am until 12 noon. You must attend the full range brief / safety instructional session to participate on the range.

For your safety, please do not wear any following: baggy upper clothing, scarves, or dangly earrings/jewelry – i.e. anything a bow string could catch on when draw back to your body. If you have longer hair, you may prefer to bring something to tie hair back.
